

WAX RECOMMENDATION

Lapham Peak State Park, Delafield, WI

Saturday, January 23

11K Skate

Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: After several days of above normal temperatures and a few freeze/thaw cycles expect transformed, sugary snow with some icy spots. Friday night low temperature around 30, rising to mid-30s by race time. Overcast with a chance of rain during the race.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply a 1:1 mixture of HF Moly/HF Yellow, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A warm universal grind or a universal grind covered by one pass with the Yellow TOKO Structurite tool (old coarse offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
