

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

MLK Day Invitational Ski Carnival -- PM races

Valleywood Golf Course, Apple Valley, MN

Monday, January 18

5K Skate pursuit start (1 P.M. Boys, 1:30 P.M. Girls)

4 x 1.3K Sprint relays (2:30 P.M. Girls, 3:30 P.M. Boys)

Forecast/Conditions: Expect a hard pack of transformed snow that will soften throughout the day with uphill turning to sugar snow. Race day will be preceded by three days of freeze/thaw cycle. Sunday evening low in the mid-20s, warming to the low 30s for these races. Mostly sunny with a slight wind from the west.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Red, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking a mix of JetStream Red/Yellow, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Structure: A universal grind covered by one pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool (old medium offset wheel) before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.

Racing - Service

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
