

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Stump Farm Open Ski Race

Green Bay Reforestation Camp, Suamico, WI

Saturday, February 20

20K/5K Skate; Open and HS Divisions

10:15 A.M. 5K; 11:30 A.M. 20K

Mass Start

Forecast/Conditions: Partly cloudy overnight with a low of 13, rising to near 20 at 5K race start and 26 at 20K start with partly cloudy skies for the duration of the event. Expect recent snow to be transformed and trail to be packed and moderately firm.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue (5K) or HF Red (20K), scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue (5K) or JetStream Red (20K), brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A fine grind covered by one pass with the Blue TOKO Structurite tool (old fine linear wheel) before JetStream application will best suit the 5K conditions. Use one pass with the Red TOKO Structurite tool for the 20K conditions.

Check the WaxTip page at www.TokoUS.com before all of your races for the latest waxing information. The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
