

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Peter Westra Memorial Sprints

Trollhagen, Dresser, WI

Friday, December 4, 4:30 P.M.

750 meter skate sprint

Time trial followed by heats

Forecast/Conditions: Thursday evening lows in the mid-teens, warming Friday to the mid 20s before dropping to low 20s at race time. This race will be on freshly shot manmade snow. With nearly 200 skiers racing and each racer guaranteed at least two races, expect the uphill to become sugary as the race gets further into the heats. Snow should remain firm but abrasive on the flats and downhill.

Glidewax: Apply LF Moly, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, sprinkle on Nordlite Powder X-cold, iron in together, scrape and brush. Finish by rotocorking JetStream Blue, brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad. Blue and X-cold are recommended even at these temperatures to combat the abrasiveness of artificial snow.

Structure: A fine linear structure covered by one pass with the blue rill of the TOKO structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.

The Toko Race Wax Tips offer racers precise waxing advice on how to make your skis perform optimally for a given event. For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream) and substitute the LF or System 3 wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue). For those who do not have a rotocork for applying JetStream, the next best thing is to iron it in.
