Forecast/Conditions: Firm and fast conditions consisting of an old but clean snowpack exists prior to the arrival of some fresh snow on Friday of at least 2-3 inches. Light snowfall is predicted Friday night with lows around 24 rising to around 28 to 30 during the citizens races with a 70 percent of continuing light snowfall.

<u>Glidewax</u>: Apply HP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, spray on HP Liquid Paraffin Yellow, let stand for at least an hour, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. You can also have great results by spraying the HP Liquid just before your start and ski while still wet with no brushing necessary. If you do not have LP, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax will best suit these conditions.
