WAX RECOMMENDATION

Cabin Creek Exit63, Hwy 90, Snoqualmie Pass, WA - Sunday, March 2 9 A.M., 50k/10k, Freestyle Wave start by distance, 50k is 5 laps http://www.kongsbergers.org

Forecast/Conditions: Unseasonably warm conditions over the past few days will start exposing some dirt in the top of the 34 inch snowpack and should be dealt with in waxing due to the multiple laps in the 50k. Saturday's high of 48 with a low of 34 Saturday night will lead to a course quickly berming on the corners and make ski selection in regard to flex and grind important considerations for dirt and moisture. A 40 percent likelihood of rain before and during event.

Glidewax: Apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Sprinkle on <u>Jet Powder</u> Yellow, make two passes with iron at 18oc, let cool, scrape and brush. Polish with a merino wool roller. Then spray on <u>Jet Liquid</u> Yellow, let the ski dry flat for at least 20 minutes. Brush with soft nylon or lightly polish Jet Liquid with a merino roller to lessen dirt sticking to the skis. More dirt will be exposed as the snowpack decreases.

Gripwax: N/A

<u>Structure</u>: A Universal or Wet structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or Jet Powder but before applying Jet Liquid will best suit these conditions.
