WAX RECOMMENDATION



KORTELOPET

Birkebeiner OO Trailhead, Seeley, WI - Friday, Feb 21 10:15 A.M. first wave, 29k, Classic or Skate Wave start, Point-to-point Birkie.com

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of about -8F, snow temperature about -2F at the start. Mostly sunny skies with a light southwest breeze. Daytime high of 22. Expect the course to be generally in good shape, with occasional dirty spots on southern portions of the course and some debris in the classic tracks. Note multiple extreme cold and windy days leading up to the race as a factor in this wax tip.

<u>Glidewax:</u> Apply Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Blue Hot Wax, sprinkle on X-Cold Powder, iron in together, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 2-4 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking smooth between layers. Cover the GripWax Blue with 1 thin layer of GripWax X-Cold to free up the ski a bit in these very cold conditions. For those wanting more grip, consider skipping the layer of GripWax X-Cold. For those who will be on the course for a longer time who want to ensure grip later in the afternoon, consider carrying GripWax Red and a cork for possible re-application during the race.

<u>Structure</u>: A fine grind with no added structure will best suit these conditions.
