## MIDWEST DIVISIONAL CXC CUP CLASSIC

Mt. Itasca, Coleraine, MN - Saturday, Feb 15 10 A.M., 7.5k Men/Women, shorter distances for youth Mass start

**Forecast/Conditions:** Overnight low of about -5F, temperature at first start time of about 1F, mostly sunny skies and blustery/breezy conditions. Daytime high will reach about 9F. Expect a machined surface comprised primarily of natural snow on a 3.75k lap.

<u>Glidewax:</u> Apply Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Then apply High Performance Blue Hot Wax, sprinkle on X-Cold Powder, iron in together, scrape and brush.

<u>Gripwax:</u> Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 2-4 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking smooth between layers. Elite racers may want to cover the GripWax Blue with 1 thin layer of GripWax X-Cold to free up the skis a bit in these very cold conditions.

<u>Structure:</u> A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax will best suit these conditions.
