WAX RECOMMENDATION



YELLOWSTONE RENDEZVOUS RACE

<u>Forecast/Conditions:</u> Overnight low 4F, air temperature at start 15 and snow temperature of 10, warming to 33 air temperature by noon with partly cloudy skies. Thursday forecast calls for 3-5 inches of new snow. Track will be firm with a mix of transformed and new snow.

<u>Glidewax:</u> Apply BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Sprinkle on <u>Jet Powder</u> Blue, make two passes with iron at 18oc, let cool, scrape and brush. Polish with a merino wool roller. Then spray on <u>Jet Liquid</u> Blue, let the ski dry flat for at least 20 minutes. Finish by lightly polishing with the merino wool roller.

<u>Gripwax:</u> Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 4 alternating layers of Nordic GripWax Red and GripWax Blue, corking smooth between layers. Finish with 1 layer of GripWax Blue.

<u>Structure</u>: A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or Jet Powder but before applying Jet Liquid will best suit these conditions.
