WAX RECOMMENDATION

<u>Forecast/Conditions:</u> Friday's overnight low will be around 20, but the temperature will quickly climb with a race time air temperature in the mid-30s. Even though the snow temperature will lag the air temperature, the snow temperature will be approaching 30. Expect firm, clean, transformed wet snow that will break down with multiple lap traffic.

<u>Glidewax:</u> Apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Sprinkle on <u>Jet Powder</u> Yellow, make two passes with iron at 18oc, let cool, scrape and brush. Polish with a merino wool roller. Then spray on <u>Jet Liquid</u> Yellow, let the ski dry flat for at least 20 minutes. No need to brush or polish Jet Liquid before skiing.

Gripwax: n/a

<u>Structure</u>: A wet structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or Jet Powder but before applying Jet Liquid will best suit these conditions.
