

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## SNEKKEVIK

Nine Mile, Wausau WI -- Saturday, Jan 10

9 A.M., 12k Adult Classic, 6k HS Classic, 3.5k MS Classic

11:45 A.M., 24k/12k, Adult Freestyle

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**Forecast/Conditions:** Expect an icy track from above-freezing temperatures in the days leading up to the event. A 60 percent chance of new snow happening during the event. Friday night's low in the low 20s with race time temperatures in the mid- to upper 20s.

**Glidewax:** Apply HP Red, scrape and brush, lightly rub on Jet Bloc Red, polish with the Rotary Brush Merino Wool, repeat the Jet Bloc rub/polish for a second coat. Then quickly (2 to 3 seconds) spray [Jet Liquid](#) Red tail to tip, spread and polish using a handheld Thermo Cork, and go ski.

**Gripwax:** Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, apply Nordic Base Klister Green, heat and smooth. While still warm, apply a Nordic Klister Red, smooth, let cool. Then apply a thin cover of Nordic GripWax Red, cork lightly. These will likely be good conditions for skin skis. If using skin skis, treat skins with Eco Skin Proof. For best performance, apply Eco Skin Proof the day before the event.

**Structure:** A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or polishing the Jet Bloc but before applying Jet Liquid will best suit these conditions.
