IMD Season Opener Classic Pursuit -- Updated!

Sunset Hills (Lindley) Trail, Bozeman, MT

Sunday, December 17

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight a slight chance of snow showers, cloudy with low around 7F. Sunday partly sunny with high near 29. Expect an abrasive packed powder track for early starters.

Glidewax: Apply LF Blue, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. U14 & under: ONLY NF waxes are permitted per IMD Rules. Use NF Blue, scrape and brush. U16 and older: IMD rules do not allow for liquid, bloc or powder pure fluoro topcoats in the Classic ski glide zone.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. For early starters, apply 3 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers. For later starters or those wanting more kick, test Red with Blue cover. Check Toko tent for updates.

Structure: A medium-fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool will best suit these conditions. Add additional structure as needed depending on moisture. A universal structure should also work well and get better as the tracks get skied in through the day.
