Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night mostly cloudy with low around 21. Sunday partly sunny, temperature at start near 22. Expect a soft track and clean snow.

Glidewax: U16 & older, apply LF Blue, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. U14 & under, apply NF Blue, scrape and brush. IMD-RMSA Waxing Rules for West Yellowstone JNQ: U16 & older, use of pure Fluoro in Bloc, Powder or Liquid form prohibited for Skate skis. U14 & Under, only NF (non-fluoro) glide waxes are permitted. LF, HF and pure Fluoro waxes prohibited.

Gripwax: n/a

Structure: A cold grind covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool will best suit these conditions.
