Forecast/Conditions: Low temperature of 28 overnight Saturday. Small chance of snow showers. Temperature rising to 35 during the day on Sunday. Partly cloudy. Manmade snow.

Glidewax: This is an LF-only race. Apply LF Red, scrape and brush,

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper. If there is no new snow, then spray on Nordic GripSpray Base Green. While still warm apply Nordic Klister Red. Later racers may want to add some Nordic Klister Yellow for more kick. If there is significant new snow, then instead of klister apply 3 layers of Nordic GripWax Red, corking between layers. Add Nordic Gripwax Yellow if extra kick needed.

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool will best suit these conditions.
