Friday, February 16

3 P.M. Boys, 4 P.M. Girls, 5K Classic

Interval Start

Single lap course

Forecast/Conditions: Thursday night a 30 percent chance of snow showers, mainly before 1 A.M. with a low around 2F. Friday mostly sunny, with race temperature near 15. West wind around 15 mph gusting to 25 mph. Expect machine worked and packed snow with firm tracks.

Glidewax: Apply LF Black, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. No pure fluorocarbons are permitted.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3-4 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers.

Structure: A fine linear grind covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool.
