

WAX RECOMMENDATION

Wilderness Lodge, Wattsburg, PA

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 34, temperature at start 37, cloudy skies with little chance of precipitation.

Glidewax: Apply LF Black, scrape and brush, then apply HF Yellow, scrape and brush. Finish by crayoning JetStream Yellow, iron hot (320F) with a layer of fiberlene under the iron, traveling slowly (60 seconds) tip to tail. Brush with a dedicated nylon polishing brush and polish with a thermopad.

Gripwax: Testing required at Race venue. One option may be: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Klister Green, heat smooth, let cool. Apply 1 layer of Nordic Klister Yellow, smooth and let cool. Then apply 1 layer of Nordic GripWax Yellow, smooth out but do not cork into the klister.

Structure: A wet grind covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool (before JetStream application) will best suit these conditions.
