

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Honey Bear Classic

24K/12K Classic, Mass start

Forecast/Conditions: Friday night scattered snow showers, mainly before 1 A.M. Mostly cloudy, with a low around zero F. Saturday partly sunny, with race temperatures near 14.

Glidewax: Apply LF Black, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3-4 layers of Nordic GripWax X-Cold, corking between layers. Those requiring more positive kick can apply GripWax Blue.

Structure: A fine linear grind covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite after brushing out the glide wax will best suit these conditions.

For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the Fluorocarbon (JetStream or HelX) and substitute the LF or NF wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue).
