Al Quaal Recreation Area, Ishpeming, MI

Friday, February 15

3 P.M. Girls, 4 P.M. Boys, 5K, Interval start

Single lap course

Forecast/Conditions: Snow showers likely, mainly before 1 P.M. Patchy blowing snow before 3 P.M. Mostly cloudy, with race temperature of 17 and gusty winds. Expect snow to fall leading up to and during the race resulting in a soft track.

Glidewax: Apply LF Blue and LF Black mixed 1:1, scrape and brush, then apply HF Blue, scrape and brush. Event regulations prohibit the use of pure fluoro top coats.

Gripwax: n/a

Structure: A fine linear grind covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool before JetStream application will best suit these conditions.
