Classical technique, Individual start

**Forecast/Conditions:** Overnight low 4F, temperature at start 17, partly cloudy skies. Manmade base with new snow mixed in, machine groomed surface.

**Glidewax:** Apply Performance Black Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP Blue/HP Red Hot Wax mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. For HP Liquid Paraffin, apply Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then spray on HP Liquid Blue, wait 30 minutes, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin

**Gripwax:** Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers. This will require testing.

**Structure:** A universal grind covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the HP layer or before spraying on the HP LP will best suit these conditions.
