

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## River View Loppet

After Hours Trails, Brule, WI

Saturday, January 4

11 A.M.

Races in order: 10K/24K Classic, 24K Skate, 10K Skate

All races mass start by gender

Two loops for 24K and one loop for 10K races

**Forecast/Conditions:** Overnight low of 17, temperature at start will be 19, snow will be softer over hard packed base. Mostly sunny skies with almost no wind.

**Glidewax:** Apply Performance Black Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply HP BlueHot Wax/HP Red Hot Wax mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. For HP Liquid Paraffin, apply Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then spray on HP Liquid Blue, let stand for at least one hour in a warm room (overnight is best), then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin.

**Gripwax:** Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue/GripWax Red alternating colors, corking between layers. Finish with Red under foot.

**Structure:** A universal grind covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the HP layer or before spraying on the HP LP will best suit these conditions.
