## Gitchi Gami Games Classic

American Birkebeiner Trailhead, Cable, WI

All Classic interval start 2-4 laps of 2.5K course

**Forecast/Conditions:** Saturday night mostly cloudy with a low around 23. Sunday mostly cloudy with race time temperatures ranging from 25-33. Course is mostly artificial snow tilled together with recent fresh snow. Expect the tracks to become glazed as the day progresses due to high skier traffic and rising temperatures.

**Glidewax:** Apply Performance Black Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply High Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush for the first race. For HP Liquid Paraffin, apply Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then spray on HP Liquid Red, let stand for at least one hour in a warm room (overnight is best), then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. For all other races substitute Yellow for the Red High Performance Hot Wax or HP Liquid Paraffin.

**Gripwax:** Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3-4 layers of Nordic GripWax Red, corking between layers. For later races substitute Nordic GripWax Yellow.

**Structure:** A universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing HP Hot Wax or before spraying HP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
