

WAX RECOMMENDATION



2020 NEBKL Festival Classic Race

Great Glen Nordic Trails, Gorham, NH

Sunday, March 1

9:30 A.M.

2K-4K, Classic

Interval start, 1K - 4K lap

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 12, clear sky.

Temperature at start 18 warming to 25 for later start times. Fresh packed snow on trails, PistenBully groomed. Partly sunny during race day.

Glidewax: This race is Non-Fluoro only. Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax/BP Red Hot Wax mixed 1:1, scrape and brush. For Liquid Paraffin, apply BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then spray on Base Performance Liquid Paraffin Blue, let stand for at least one hour in a warm room (overnight is best), then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3 layers of Nordic GripWax Red, corking between layers, Later races may move to Gripwax Yellow.

Structure: A Cold grind covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final hot wax layer or before spraying Liquid Paraffin will best suit these conditions.
