Forecast/Conditions: Temps in upper 40s throughout week, Friday night low of 38F with a 2:30PM start temp of 40F. 90% cloud cover with a strong chance of rain/snow Saturday afternoon. Expect moist and transformed snow. Some tree sap might be present.

Glidewax: Apply Performance Black Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply a 1:1 mix of High Performance Red/Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush. For HP Liquid Paraffin, apply Performance Black Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then spray on HP Liquid Red, let sit for 30 minutes (overnight is best), polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin.

Structure: A wet or universal structure will best suit these conditions; the wet grind will not require additional hand structure. A universal grind should be covered by one pass with the yellow Structurite tool followed by a single pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing HP Hot Wax or before spraying HP Liquid Paraffin.

For racers who don't have top end waxes, skip the High Performance (Liquid Paraffin or Hot Wax) and substitute the Performance or Base Performance wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue).
