

WAX RECOMMENDATION

Rolling start, 25K lap

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 30 degrees, rain then partly cloudy. Temperature at start 33 degrees. Granular packed snow trails, PistenBully groomed. Mostly sunny race day.

Glidewax: Apply Performance Black Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then apply High Performance Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush. For HP Liquid Paraffin, apply Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush, then spray on HP Liquid Yellow, let stand for at least one hour in a warm room (overnight is best), then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A Warm grind grind covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing HP hot wax or before spraying HP Liquid Paraffin will best suit these conditions.
