Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 19, temperature at start mid-20s. Snow is entirely manmade, firm and clean with some new, freshly shot manmade on parts of the course.

Glidewax: Apply Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on High Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush for Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have HP Liquid spray, after scraping and brushing Performance Blue Hot Wax, apply High Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3-4 layers of Nordic GripWax Red, corking between layers.

Structure: A fine universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying HP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
