## Bogus Challenge #2 New Year's Skate

Bogus Basin Nordic, Boise, ID

Saturday, January 2

3 P.M.

15K/5K/1K, Skate

Interval start

2 laps

**Forecast/Conditions:** New snow throughout week, expect soft untransformed snow. Friday night low of 23, Saturday high of 30 falling to 28 at start. A 90 percent cloud cover with a 40 percent chance of snow during race. Track may soften up during second lap.

**Glidewax:** Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

**Structure:** A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
