

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Wasatch Citizen Series Race #1

Soldier Hollow, Midway, UT

Self-scheduled event that can be completed between Saturday, December 19, and Monday, December 28.

This tip is for Saturday/Sunday, December 19 and 20
10K, Freestyle

Forecast/Conditions: Friday overnight low 11 degrees. Saturday 10 A.M. temperature about 25 and warming to a high of 36. Sunday 10 A.M. temperature about 30 and warming to 40. Snow is entirely manmade and clean with freshly shot new manmade snow drifting onto the course in some places. The freshly shot snow is very slow and it helps to use a very hard glide wax.

Glidewax: If skiing before 11 A.M. either day, apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush. If skiing after 11 A.M., apply Base Performance Blue, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red LP, let stand overnight, then polish with Polishing Brush. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply the same color of Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Structure: A cold universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP LP will best suit these conditions.

If an event allows fluorinated waxes and you choose to use them, use High Performance or Performance (Liquid Paraffin or Hot Wax) of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue), as the temperature ranges are the same.
