

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Noquemanon Virtual Races - Sunday

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night a 50 percent chance of snow showers after 1 A.M. Mostly cloudy with a steady temperature around 19. Sunday a 60 percent chance of snow showers, mainly before 1 P.M. Mostly cloudy with a high near 27. Expect fresh snow over semi-firm tracks.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3-5 layers of Nordic GripWax Red, corking between layers.

Structure: A fine structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions .
