## Bogus Challenge #3 - Skate

Bogus Basin Nordic, Boise, ID

Wednesday, January 13

5:30 P.M.

10K/5K/1K Skate

Interval start

2 laps

Forecast/Conditions: Snow and rain expected Tuesday with rain on Wednesday. Tuesday night low of 36, Wednesday high of 36 cooling to 32 at start. An 80 percent chance of rain or snow during race. Expect a soft and wet track. Racing under the lights of Red Tail and Sapper's Return but a headlamp is still recommended.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Yellow Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Red Hot Wax, apply BP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Structure: A stiff ski with a universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
