Forecast/Conditions: Friday night partly cloudy, with a low around negative 1F at 6 A.M. Saturday mostly cloudy, 15 at start rising to 20 at finish. Expect packed powder with firm tracks.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on BP LP Blue, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply an additional layer of BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3 layers of Nordic GripWax Blue, corking between layers. Cover with 1 layer of Nordic GripWax X-Cold and cork smooth.

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying Liquid will best suit these conditions.
