

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## **Skinny Santa Solstice Ski**

Woodland Trails, Elk River, MN

Saturday, January 23

9 A.M. start

10K and 20K Freestyle, 10K lap

Waves of 25 leave in five minute increments

**Forecast/Conditions:** Overnight low of 1F rising to 6F for the first starters. Slight chance of snow during the race. Expect machine worked, transformed snow under a mostly cloudy sky with a slight wind. This challenging course has some of the best natural snow cover in the metro area.

**Glidewax:** Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, sprinkle on X-cold Powder, iron in together, let cool, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Yellow Liquid Paraffin Polishing Brush. If you do not have LP spray, apply the first layer of BP Blue Hot Wax without X-cold Powder, then apply a second layer of BP Blue Hot Wax, sprinkle on X-cold Powder, iron in together, let cool, scrape and brush.

**Structure:** A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
