All Skate, Interval start

1-2 laps of 5K course

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night a chance of flurries.

Cloudy, with a low around 15. North wind around 5 mph becoming calm.

Sunday mostly cloudy, with race time temperature of 25. Northwest wind around 5 mph becoming calm. Expect a mixture of fresh snow and fresh over/mixed into solid base of artificial snow.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal grind covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax layer or before spraying on the BP LP will best suit these conditions.
