

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Duluth Super CXC Cup Classic

Grand Avenue Nordic Center, Duluth, MN

Sunday, January 24

10 A.M. start

7.5K Freestyle all age groups

Interval start on 2.5K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night snow likely, mainly before midnight. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 14. A 70 percent chance of precipitation. Sunday partly sunny, with race time temperatures 17-20. Expect some fresh snow mixed with highly transformed artificial snow.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Blue Hot Wax and BP Red Hot Wax mixed 1:1, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A fine structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
