

WAX RECOMMENDATION **TOKO**[®]

Soldier Hollow Nordic Center, Midway, UT

Sunday, February 21

9:30 A.M. or later, self-start. This is an untimed Freestyle event.

1, 2 or 3 laps on a 16.7K course. Three laps will equal the 50K course of the 2002 Olympics.

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low about 17. Temperature at 9:30 A.M. in the mid-20s and rising to max in the upper 30s and sunny. The course will be run on a mixture of manmade snow and natural snow trails with lots of climbing. The 50K course totals 4,995 feet of climbing.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush for Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply a layer of BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Structure: A fine universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool followed by one pass with the Blue wheel after scraping and brushing the final BP Red Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
