

WAX RECOMMENDATION



Ski to the Sun Marathon and Relay

Mazama Corral Trailhead, Mazama, WA

Saturday, February 6, and Sunday, February 7

Self-scheduled event, final two days

30K/10K, Classic or Free Technique

Forecast/Conditions: Adequate depth and fully transformed snow conditions groomed daily by PistenBully. Overnight lows of 27 Friday night and 23 Saturday night with daytime highs of 37 Saturday and 32 Sunday at the finish. Mostly sunny skies for both days but with a 20 percent chance of snow after 10 A.M. on Saturday. Road crossing areas will be dirty.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Yellow Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight or longer, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Red Hot Wax, apply BP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Same Glidewax if starting after 11 A.M.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in a thin layer of Nordic Base Klister Green, cork smooth, let cool and then cover with Nordic Klister Red. Cork smooth, let cool before skiing. Early starters on Sunday may benefit from mixing Nordic Klister Blue with Klister Red.

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions for early starters.
