Forecast/Conditions: A fully transformed, adequate depth snow pack that should be fairly firm and fast. Overnight low expected around 21 Saturday night with daytime high of 35. Mostly sunny skies are expected with snow temperature reaching freezing by noon to 1 PM.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Yellow Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight or longer, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray and race in the AM, race on BP Red Hot Wax. Those racing after noon without LP Spray should race on BP Yellow Hot Wax.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool for morning racers or Yellow Structurite tool for afternoon racers, after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
