Wax tip for Feb. 13/14, assumes a 10 A.M. start

15K, 5K, 2K, 1K and 0.5K, Freestyle Technique

Forecast/Conditions: New course! Significant snowfall is predicted Friday night through 10 A.M. Saturday resulting in a soft skate platform, especially on Saturday. Overnight lows expected of 10F Friday night and 14 Saturday night. Snow temperatures expected of 14 Saturday and 19 Sunday at 10 A.M. A 70 percent chance of snow Saturday and a 60 percent chance of snow Sunday.

Glidewax: For both days, apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight or longer, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, add a second layer of BP Blue Hot Wax, especially if your skis have most recently been waxed with warmer waxes.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine or universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
