3K or 9K, Freestyle technique

Rolling start

3K lap

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 16, temperature at start 19.
Natural new fallen snow, packed powder, machine groomed surface
under partly cloudy skies.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.
Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then
polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP
spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot
Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue
Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or
before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
