20K, Freestyle technique

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight lows 22-30, temperature at start around 32. Thursday into Saturday there is up to 50 percent chance of new snow, and windy. Sunday and Monday have colder overnight temperatures, but sunny and warmer during the day.

Glidewax: For Friday, Saturday and Monday: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. For Sunday morning use the Blue/Blue combo.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
