Bogus Challenge - Tour of Bogus

Bogus Basin Nordic, Boise, ID

Saturday, February 20

1K/10K/25K, Skate or Classic

Mass start

Single lap

Forecast/Conditions: Several inches of snow throughout the week. Track could be soft. Friday night low of 20, start temperature of 24. A 30 percent chance of snow during the race.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply a second layer of BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 1 layer of Nordic GripWax Red and cork smooth. Add an additional layer of Red if more kick is needed or cover with a layer of Nordic GripWax Blue if more glide is needed. Cork smooth any additional layers.

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
