

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Kincaid Freestyle

Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

Sunday, February 14

Noon

10K, 5K, 3K, Freestyle

Interval start

Two laps or one lap, depending on distance

**Forecast/Conditions:** Saturday night low 5F to 15 above. Sunday partly cloudy, high in the 20s. A few inches fell on Tuesday but no new snow in the forecast. There is a good base and the course should be in excellent condition.

**Glidewax:** Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply an additional layer of BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

**Structure:** A fine universal structure covered by two passes with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
