Forecast/Conditions: Overnight lows in the upper 20s with highs in the upper 30s. Up to a 100 percent chance of new snow expected off and on during the long weekend and light winds expected daily.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Yellow Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Red Hot Wax, apply BP Red/BP Yellow Hot Wax mixed 1:1, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
