Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 9F, temperature at start 15 warming up to 23. Mostly sunny during the day. Natural snow on top of transformed natural snow, PistenBully groomed.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have BP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot Wax layer, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: n/a

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
