

# WAX RECOMMENDATION



## Boyne Vistas

Boyne Mountain, Boyne Falls, MI

Sunday, February 7

10:30 A.M., 15 second interval starts

12K Seniors/8K Juniors, Freestyle, 4K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Saturday night mostly cloudy with a low around 6F. Sunday mostly cloudy, 9F at start, holding steady. Expect packed powder with falling and blowing snow.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on BP Liquid Paraffin Blue, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply a second layer of BP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying Liquid Paraffin will best suit these conditions.
