9:30 A.M. Juniors U16 and under

20K Skate, 15 second Interval Start

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 23, temperature in the upper 20s during the race. Snow possible before and during the race. Expect a soft track with a lot of new, fresh snow.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush for Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply a layer of BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A fine universal structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
