Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 20 rising to 22 at the start. Meager snowfall earlier in the week will be mixed in with manmade snow. Course will be worked with PistenBully. Partly sunny with 5 mph winds from the South.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, iron, let cool, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Yellow Liquid Paraffin Polishing Brush. If you do not have LP spray, apply a 1:1 mixture of BP Blue Hot Wax and BP Red Hot Wax, iron, let cool, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A fine structure covered by one pass with the Red Structurite tool followed by a single pass of the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax layer or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
