Hillside to Kincaid Park, Anchorage, AK

50K / 40K / 25K, Skate and Classic events

Point-to-point race

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low around 10F, temperature at start near 20. Well-groomed clean snow that will fall Friday and Saturday. Mostly sunny.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: Roughen base with 150 grit sandpaper, iron in Nordic Base Wax Green, cork smooth, let cool. Then apply 3 layers of Nordic GripWax Red, corking between layers.

Structure: A universal stonegrind covered by one light pass with the Red Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
