Forecast/Conditions: New snow on Friday but the snow temperatures are consistent over the four days. Day temperatures in the upper 30s-40s with overnight temperatures in the mid-20s. Expect transforming snow with a 20 percent chance of new snow on Saturday morning.

Glidewax: Apply Base Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on Base Performance Red Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Blue Hot Wax, apply BP Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Depending upon when you ski, you may want to add Yellow Hot Wax to the Red Hot Wax 1:1

Gripwax: N/A

Structure: A universal structure covered by one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing the final BP Hot Wax or before spraying BP Liquid will best suit these conditions.
