10K, Skate technique

Interval start format on a 5K loop

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low 15, temperature at start in the low to mid-20s. Possibly some new snow from 24 hours earlier mixed in with very old and partially transformed granular snow.

Glidewax: All WCS events are now fluoro-free. Apply High Performance Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on High Performance Blue Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush for Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing HP Blue Hot Wax, apply a second layer of HP Blue Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: n/a

Structure: A fine universal stone ground structure covered by one pass with the Blue Structurite tool after scraping and brushing HP Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions.

If you do not have High Performance wax, substitute Performance or Base Performance wax of the same color (Yellow, Red or Blue), as the temperature ranges are the same. All Race Wax Tips recommend ONLY fluorine-free products. Older HP or P Toko waxes (Liquid or Hot Wax) contain fluorine. New labels look very similar but all say PFC Free.
