Wave starts by distance

15K is 3 laps

Forecast/Conditions: Overnight low of 22 following three days with predicted 50 percent chance of minor daily snowfall at temperatures between 26 and 31. Conditions should be a bit cleaner and with a firm platform with race time snow temperature between 28-30.

Glidewax: Apply High Performance Red Hot Wax, scrape and brush. Spray on High Performance Yellow Liquid Paraffin, let stand overnight, then polish with the Polishing Brush Liquid Paraffin. If you do not have LP spray, after scraping and brushing BP Red Hot Wax, apply HP Yellow Hot Wax, scrape and brush.

Gripwax: NA

Structure: A universal structure by itself or covering a linear structure with one pass with the Yellow Structurite tool after scraping and brushing HP Hot Wax or before spraying HP LP will best suit these conditions.
